PARTICIPANT RULES

- All competitors must be sworn, full-time or retired law enforcement officers in the state of Kentucky. There will be a separate competition for DOCJT employees.
- All DOCJT Range Safety Rules will be followed by all competitors during the competition.
- DOCJT Firearms staff reserves the right to disallow any weapon or item of leather gear for this competition. Weapons, holster, belt and belt gear must be those normally carried on duty.
- Barrels longer than 5.32 inches will not be allowed. Accepted modifications: actions must conform to factory specifications; sights must be those normally installed by the manufacturer—after market sights will be allowed only if they are duty sights; Sight blackening will not be allowed the barrel must be the barrel normally installed by the manufacturer--ported or compensated barrels will not be allowed.
- All weapons and leather gear will be inspected by the DOCJT Firearms staff at check-in. The DOCJT Firearms staff reserves the right to disallow any weapon or item of leather gear for this competition.
- All shooters must register as an individual competitor to be eligible to compete as a team member, or compete in the Combat Course.
- A tie-breaking course will be announced if necessary. No more than 20 rounds will be fired for the tie-breaker.
- **NO alcoholic beverages will be permitted.**

All decisions made by the DOCJT Firearms staff will be final

Additional information:

- Bring your own eye and ear protection.
- Bring 100 rounds of duty ammunition for the target course. The Combat Course will be fired with the duty weapon and consists of 6 rounds. If you plan to shoot the Combat Course more than once, bring the appropriate number of rounds.

COMPETITIONS

Awards based on Lewis Scoring System.


Individual— After an individual completes the course of fire, that score will be used in both their Individual and Team scores (if applicable). No re-shoots will be allowed.

Team—Combined score from each member. There is no limit on the number of teams an agency may enter. The winning team will receive an award for each officer. In addition, a Championship Cup will be awarded to the winning team for display at their agency for 1 year. Second and third place teams will receive an award for each officer.

Combat—Shooters will be electronically timed. There is no limit on the number of times this course may be shot. The Combat Course will be announced the day of the match. It will be a revolver-neutral, 6-round course. Registration fee entitles each shooter to fire the Combat Course once. Each additional try costs \$5.00 or you can receive a package of 5 attempts for \$20.00.

Retired—Retired Class will be Honorably, Retired Sworn Officers from a Law Enforcement Agency in the State of Kentucky.

DOCJT Staff—DOCJT employees will be competing, as a separate category.



DOCJT COMPETITION SHOOT COURSE

STAGE 1 Shooter assumes prone position.
40 yards On command, shooter fires 6 rounds from the prone position.
6 rounds **Time limit: 15 seconds**

STAGE 2 On command, shooter fires 12 rounds from a strong-hand kneeling position.
25 yards **12 rounds** **Time limit: 30 seconds**

STAGE 3 On command, shooter fires 6 rounds standing strong-hand, 6 rounds standing weak-hand.
15 yards **12 rounds** **Time limit: 10 seconds for each phase**

STAGE 4 On command, shooter fires 6 rounds standing strong-hand. Repeat.
10 yards **12 rounds** **Time limit: 8 seconds for each phase**

STAGE 5 On command, shooter fires 6 rounds strong-hand unsupported (one hand).
5 yards **6 rounds** **Time limit: 5 seconds**

- All stages begin with the shooter holstered and strapped (except for Stage 1, the prone position).
- No time allowances will be made for weapon or ammunition stoppages or malfunctions.
- Penalty points will be assessed for shooting from an improper position or firing after the time limit (maximum value of shot(s) fired).
- No "alibi" shots will be fired.
- After the initial loading designated by the Range Officer, it is the shooter's responsibility to ensure a loaded weapon and/or magazine during the course. *Time will be given to load magazines.*

BRING A TEAM FROM ANOTHER AGENCY THAT DID NOT COMPETE IN 2008 AND EACH TEAM MEMBER OF THE REFERRING TEAM WILL GET ONE FREE COMBAT SHOOT PER TEAM MEMBER.
